
#### **Use of Water Softening Systems**


In order to achieve the ideal cleaning effect, dishwashers need to use soft water with low hardness, due to the different water quality in different places, this product comes with a water softening device, when the lack of salt indicator " $\mathfrak{S}$ " light up, please add special salt promptly.

#### ■ Loaded with special salt

- a.Remove the bottom shelf and open the water softener cover by turning counterclockwise (Fig. a, Fig. b);
- b.Add approximately 1 kg of water to the water softener of the dishwasher for the first use only (Fig. c);
- c.Use the salt addition funnel to add dishwasher-safe salt to the water softener (Figure d). To accelerate the dissolution of salt in water, use a spoon to stir;
- d.After the salt is added, tighten the water softener cover.









Immediately after the special salt is added, a "Quick" program is run to remove any residual salt from the chamber.
In water softening systems, always use dishwasher-safe salt. The use of salt that is not




- completely dissolved in water, such as refined table salt or rock salt, is strictly prohibited.

   Up to 1kg of special salt can be added to the water softener.
- Specialized salt may take longer to dissolve in water. The salt deficiency indicator will remain on for a period of time after the dishwasher has been refilled with special salt.
- Open the water softener cover only when adding special salt.

#### **Use of Detergent Dispenser**

#### ■ Introduction of detergent




#### Adding detergent

Add detergent to the detergent dispenser as shown in the figure below:

- 1.Press the locking pin in the direction of the arrow (Fig. a) to open the detergent compartment lid;
- 2.Add the recommended amount of powder or lump detergent to the detergent cartridge (Figure b);
- Note: Inside the detergent dispenser, there are volume markings for adding detergent by referring to the main program instructions table on page 11;
  - Prewash detergent is placed in the prewash box, refer to the main program instructions table on page 11 for dosage.

3. Push the detergent lid in the direction of the arrow (Fig. c) and the lid will "click" to indicate that it is closed (Fig. d).



Please use special detergent in the dishwasher in powder or block form, no detergent should be used and it is recommended not to use detergents containing chlorine and phosphates.
Pay attention to the warning information on the detergent packaging and contact the detergent




manufacturer if you have further questions.

Attention When using the Quick wash in the main program or the Half Load wash in the add-on function, it is not recommended to use wash block products, there may be cause a situation where the polyester block cannot be completely dissolved.

#### ■ Adding rinse aid

A special rinse aid is required in the dishwasher. To ensure the drying effect, when the rinse aid light is missing "">

"When it lights up, please add rinse aid promptly. The rinse aid can be used multiple times with a single addition. Add the following steps:

- 1. Open the rinse aid cartridge lid as shown in figure (Figure a);
- 2.Add rinse aid until the "MAX (maximum)" scale is reached (Figure b);
- 3. Close the rinse aid cartridge lid (Figure c).








#### ■ Tableware type suggestions

- Ordinary ceramics (not including glazed porcelain), plastic (some thermoplastics may be deformed or faded due to high temperatures), glass (delicate glassware or crystal glassware containing lead may lose its luster after frequent cleaning), stainless steel tableware are generally available for dishwasher cleaning.
- Wooden tableware or utensils with wooden parts may be deformed or cracked due to high temperatures. The color coated glaze may fade after several washes. Copper, brass, tin and aluminum items may tarnish or fade after multiple washes. Dishwasher cleaning is not recommended.
- Iron products, aluminum products, and Teflon coated non-stick pans are not recommended for cleaning and are prone to rusting or chemical reactions after washing.
- Crafts, antiques, valuable vases and decorative glassware should not be washed in the dishwasher.
- Always check the instructions provided by the tableware manufacturer to see if the dishes are dishwasher

- Remove larger food debris (bones, seeds, etc.) from dishes before placing them in the dishwasher.
- It is recommended to arrange the tableware as shown.

#### ■ Tableware incorrect placement diagram










- The tableware is placed reasonably, please do not let the tableware block the rotation of the spray arm.
- Do not overlap or squeeze the dishes together in the shelves.
- Do not place dishes upwards.


#### ■ Tea cup holder

The tea cup holder can be lift up or lay down according to the direction of the arrow in the left figure, while the small bracket on the tea cup holder can be erected or lowered according to the direction of the arrow in the right figure.



#### ■ Knife and fork basket

The knife and fork basket can be used with the lid open for easy access; at the same time, the cage can be placed in different positions on the bottom shelf according to the placement of the washing utensils.



#### **Program Settings**

#### ■ Turn on the dishwasher

Open the dishwasher door and long press " 🕛 " button to turn on the dishwasher and enter the program selection.

#### ■ Start-up procedure

- 1.Select the program and press " ( )" button to start
- 2. The program starts running after closing the dishwasher door.

Important: It is recommended to select the program depending on the type of items to be cleaned and the amount of food residue.

#### Additional Features

Additional features can be used as needed. Additional features include Half load, Anti-Bac, Dry, and Delay.

#### Half load

Press "  $\frac{1}{2}$ "key, select the bottom spray arm after working alone, cleaning a small amount of tableware, tableware should be placed in the bottom shelf.

#### Anti-Bac

Press " (3) " key, select and then enhance the germ removal effect to enhance the germ removal of tableware.

#### Dry

Press "%" key to enhance the drying effect, the program ends automatically open the timed air change function; long press "%" key to directly open the timed air change function;

#### Delay

Press "(L)" key to set the delay time. The delay time is optional for 1h-24h, each press increases 1h, long press "(L)" key, the delay time is accelerated to jump. No delay time by default. After setting the delay time to start, long press "(L)" key cancels the delay and returns to the program status.

#### Additional functions operation method:

- 1. Selecting the main program first, then followed by the additional functions;
- 2. Additional functions will be cancelled when the main program changes;
- 3. When the main program and additional functions cannot be overlapped, the corresponding additional function icon flashes and then lights off;
- 4.After the main program and additional functions are selected, press ""> " The program runs automatically after the door is closed.

#### End of program

All lights go off after the process finishes.

Note: 1. Open the door during the process, and press "()"key before re-running and then close the door, the process continues.

2. After the machine starts, open the door and long press " ( ) " key to reset the program.

#### **User Operation Settings**

While the machine is on standby status, long press " wey and " ½" key for 3s simultaneously, enter the user setting interface, the digital tube shows dx(d0-d6), at this time you can set the rinse aid level; then press " key, the digital tube display Hx (H0-H8), at this time can be set for water softener regeneration gear; then press " key, the digital tube displays Lx (L0-L1), at this time, you can set the interior light; then press " key, the digital tube displays bx (b0-b1), at this time, you can set the sound. (See below for specific settings)

#### ■ Rinse aid stall setting

When the digital tube displays dx(d0-d6), the current machine rinse aid setting level is displayed, press " $\frac{1}{2}$ " key to enter the rinse aid stall setting and the digital tube displays d0-d6 cycle. d0 represents the least amount of rinsing dose, d6 represents the most, and the factory default setting is d4.If changes are needed, we recommend contacting local customer service.

#### ■ Water softener regeneration gear setting

Digital tube display Hx (H0-H8), display the current machine water softening setting gear, press "1/2" key, enter the water softener regeneration gear setting, digital tube display H0-H8 cycle, the factory default setting is H5.

#### Water hardness and salt level comparison table

If the local water hardness is not within the H5 range, please adjust the water softener regeneration gear according to the actual water hardness, referring to the above-mentioned comparison table. If changes are needed, we recommend contacting local customer service.

#### ■ Interior light settings

When the digital tube displays Lx (L0-L1), the current set gear of the machine interior light is displayed, press "1/2" button to enter the interior light stall setting and the digital tube displays L0-L1 cycle. L0 means the interior light is off, L1 means the interior light is on, and the factory default setting is L1.

#### ■ Sound settings

When the digital tube displays bx(b0-b1), the current machine sound setting gear is displayed, press " $\frac{1/2}{2}$ " key to enter the sound stall setting and the digital tube displays b0-b1 cycle. b0 means the buzzer has no sound, b1 means the buzzer has sound, the factory default setting is b1.

Note: • After the above settings are set, 10s without operation, the settings will be saved automatically and the machine will shut down and exit; you can also press "()" key to save the setting manually and the machine turns into the program selection state.

• All the above operations should be operated when the door is open.


#### **Important Notes:**


- 1.After opening the package, check and ensure that no damage has been caused in transit. If the product is damaged, please do not connect the power supply and contact our after-sales service.
- 2.After installation is complete, make sure that the power cord or water supply and drainage hoses are not pressed
- 3.Do not connect the dishwasher to the power supply throughout the installation process.
- 4.If you need to adjust the installation, please leave the electrical and plumbing related operations to the professionals.
- 5. Check that the dishwasher grounding is reliable.
- 6.All electrical and plumbing work during the installation of the dishwasher must be performed by a professional.
- 7.If your dishwasher is running abnormally, please cut off the circuit to shut off the water supply and contact the after-sales service.
- 8. For safety reasons, do not keep the dishwasher door fully opening after use.
- 9.Before first use, make sure to remove all packaging and fixing accessories.

#### Connection to water supply


1.Check and ensure the water pressure: 0.1MPa-1.0MPa; you can contact the local water supply agency to consult the local water pressure, if the water pressure is too high, please install a regulator. 2.Dishwasher hose connection for water supply: connect the threaded end of the hose to the triangle valve (faucet), the thread of the water inlet fitting for this machine is G3/4".



WARNING: New hose-sets supplied with the appliance are to be used and that old hose-sets should /!\ not be reused.



∦ If the water pipe is new or not used for a long time, you should open the water valve and let the water flow for a while, until the water becomes clear and free of impurities before connecting to the dishwasher inlet pipe. %Check if the hose seal is intact and the connection is tight (Figure A).





- \*Avoid twisting and compression of the hose (Figure B).
- \*When the dishwasher is not in use, turn off the water tap.

#### Wastewater discharge


1. You can connect the end of the drain hose to a vent U-bend or a sink U-bend; when connecting to a U-bend, the top baffle must be removed and the rubber end fully installed, using clamps if necessary.



Note: Make sure to secure the drain hose in place to prevent leaks.

2. When the drainage pipe is installed, the highest drainage port does not exceed the height of the whole machine, and the drainage port is strictly prohibited to be submerged in water.


Important: When installing the hose, slowly pull the hose, such as hose kink, compression, may interrupt the water flow or reduce the flow rate; drainage pipe more than 3 meters will affect the normal operation of the dishwasher.




#### ■ Electrical connection


Before connecting the dishwasher ensure that:


- 1. The electrical connection information on the product nameplate sticker must match your power requirements;
- 2. The dishwasher must be connected to a dedicated outlet with grounding;
- 3.If it is necessary to connect to a voltage different from that stated, an appropriate transformer must be used and a suitably qualified electrician must adjust and ensure that the electrical installation complies with the regulations.
  - After installation, please make sure not to cover the socket.
- Do not connect power through patch panels, duplex sockets or electrical delay devices (as shown below).
- The Company will not be responsible for any accidents caused by missing grounding devices or grounding faults.




#### ■ Installation steps (dimensions shown in the figure is mm)









### Maintenance

#### Clean this product regularly

Regular cleaning of this product will prolong its life and reduce some common problems.

You must unplug the power and turn off the faucet before cleaning.



- Attention No substances of abrasive nature should be used for cleaning.
  - To ensure efficient operation of this equipment, the filter and spray arms should be cleaned at least once a week.

#### Clean the outer surface of this product

Use a neutral cleaning material and a damp rag to wipe the outer surface of this product. Use only a slightly damp cloth to wipe the "control panel".

#### ■ Cleaning the inside of the dishwasher

\*\* Based on the degree of soiling, determine whether to add detergent and then run the program to clean the inside of the dishwasher and the water tank.

\* If water remains in the dishwasher, remove the filter as described in "Cleaning filters" below and check the bottom of the dishwasher for any residue that may have accumulated and caused a block in the water line. Clean as needed.


#### Cleaning filters

To ensure efficient operation of this equipment, the filter should be cleaned at least once a week. Check for food residue on the filter. If there is food residue on the filter, remove the filter and rinse it by water.


- 1. Turn the fine and coarse filter assembly approximately 1/4 turn counterclockwise and withdraw the fine and coarse filter assembly from the base.
- 2. Press the two jaws of the coarse filter inward and separate the coarse filter from the assembly.
- 3. Using a brush, clean the removed filter by water.
- 4. Placement of fine and coarse filtration components.
- 5. Put the coarse filter back into the fine filter. Make sure it is properly snug. Turn the fine and coarse filter assemblies clockwise until the arrows of the fine filter line up with the arrows of the flat filter screen.
  - \*Do not use the dishwasher without a filter installed.
  - \*Improper placement of the filter will reduce washing effect.

#### ■ Clean spray arms


- 1.Check that the hole in the bottom spray arm is not blocked. If blocked, disassemble and clean the bottom spray arm. Pull down the bottom spray arm upward to check the processing.
- 2.Check if the hole in the middle spray arm is blocked. If blocked, disassemble and clean the middle spray arm. Turn the middle spray arm fixing piece in the direction of the arrow to remove the middle spray arm.
- 3. When installing the middle spray arm, be sure to fully tighten the middle spray arm retainer.




Take out the bottom spray arm

## Troubleshooting of General faults
